Robert Parker: "A terrific wine for the vintage, Latour's 1993 reveals an opaque purple color, a backward, cedar, black walnut, cassis, and earth-scented nose, medium to full body, gorgeously rich, concentrated fruit, moderately high tannin, and a sweet, long, powerful finish."

1994 Château l'Angelus, St.Emilion.....\$67.99

93 Parker points: "heavenly scents of smoked meats, barbeque spices, hickory wood, and plenty of cassis and kirsch liqueur. The fruit's phenomenal purity and denseness, as well as its overall balance is admirable in view of the massive, muscular personality of this huge, full-bodied wine oozing with extract. At the Lake with Real Wine

Dateline December 5, 2002 at about 8:30 pm. Almost finished with the January 2003 newsletter—scary thought, 2003! What happened to the '60s, '70s, '80s, and '90s? January 2003, Vol 24, Issue 1. As the waiter at Harvey's Sage room opened my bottle, I thought what a perfect place to drink this lovely wine! 1996 Château Pavie and Harvey's Sage Room at South Shore Lake Tahoe are a great match. Jean-Paul Valette's last vintage at Pavie, and perhaps the last true Pavie to be produced—a bit rustic with a bit too much old oak on the nose, but fine terroir on the palate and a smooth finish. We all know that 1996 was not a great year for the right bank (definitely a cabernet-dominated year), but this wine is very sound and friendly—no flashy garage wine here. Just like the Sage Room at Harvey's: a bit dated but friendly and cozy. Waiters in their black tuxs serving people from all over the world and in all states of dress. The menu hasn't changed in the forty years I've been eating here (my parents loved the place). Do you want the Veal Oscar or the Prime Rib or the Steak Diane? Of course soup or salad come with the entrée and maybe a first course of Prawns Scampi style? No pretense, no fancy stuff, just good tasting food at a reasonable price. Jean-Paul Valette, we miss you and your great wines; Harvey's Sage Room, I'll be back next month when I'm doing the February newsletter.

What does it look like for wines this year? Will Bordeaux come up with a miracle 2002 vintage? Rumors are that the 2002 Red Burgundy wines are very good. The Rhône will be another story—a possible disaster, thanks to the flooding in September. And will Italy and Germany come up with great vintages again? Italy has made up for the previous 1,980 years with about 20 great vintages in a row . . . perhaps the better wine-making techniques have something to do with it? There's a boatload of Aussie wines on the horizon—make that ten boatloads—as Australia, in only about 40 years of serious wine production, tries to produce more wine than either Italy or France. Spanish wines are hot, scoring a lot of points and reasonably priced. Will the fair pricing continue or will the points go to their heads? And what about California? 2000 Cabernets and 2001 Chardonnays and 2002 Sauvignon Blancs. There will be plenty of wine for sale, and we hope the prices will drop a bit. 2003 should be a buyers market for wine. Happy 2003!

Tour the Best of Bordeaux for Great Value!

Sunday afternoons in January are my special times to wind down and curl up with my new favorite wine book. This new year it will be Michael Broadbent's *Vintage Wine: Fifty Years of Tasting Three Centuries of Wines*. What a treat to meet the legend himself in November at the Redwood City store. He was in a great mood and our customers loved meeting him. His new book is full of entertaining sidebars that recall memorable events of great wines, people, and places. I was reminded of our hard work in Bordeaux, and the wonderful estates and people that consistently make great wine. To make a couple of barrels of fine wine is one thing, but to make thousands and thousands of bottles of great wine is quite another feat, and one that Bordeaux does almost every year.

After the long journey to Bordeaux, the first thing I do after checking in at Les Sources de Caudalie, located in the vineyards of **Château Smith Haut-Lafite**, is to open a half bottle of their luscious white. The wine has an exotic, rich style, and much of its exotic flavor is a result of the brand new oak barrels made right at the estate. The passion of the Cathiard family in the vineyard ensures outstanding quality fruit year to year; the spectacular **2000 Blanc** is **\$39.95**. Just down the road from Smith is another favorite—**Château Haut-Bailly**. Under the direction of Veronique Sanders, this estate makes fine traditional wine, with dark fruit, hints of violets and deep, ripe raspberry, surrounded by a firm backbone of tannin. The flavor is tinged with minerals. The **1997** at **\$27.99** is "a lovely drink today" according to my good friend Walt Campbell from Seattle; I agree.

North to the Médoc, is **Château Pichon Longueville-Baron**. Although we've never ran into the Baron's ghost, we sure have enjoyed the masculine Pichon wines. The **1995 (\$49.95)** is back with us in limited supply. It's a wine you can drink after decanting an hour plus. The deep cherry fruit meshes well with the mushroom/earth and chocolate tones. Another great Pichon is the neighboring **Château Pichon-Lalande**, one of K&L's favorites. Most of our customers fall in love at first taste, as did Clyde and I when we first tasted it in 1978. The Comtesse wine is almost as elegant, warm and generous as the proprietor herself, Madame May-Eliane de Lencquesaing. The outstanding merlot crop of the '98 vintage makes up 30% of the blend, the rest is 50% cabernet sauvignon, 15% cabernet Franc. It's 100% delicious and a steal at **\$49.99**.

1996 Château Léoville-Barton (\$58.99) and **Château Pontet-Canet (\$41.99)** are two great wines for laying the foundation of a fine wine collection/cellar. Both are loaded with serious dark black fruit, acid, and tannin. Cellar them 8-10 years and you won't be sorry. 1996 is a great, classic vintage. 2001 Castano Hecula (\$7.99) 91 points from Robert Parker. The Hecula is their 100% mourvedre offering—fat, rich, and way yummy! Here's what Mr Parker says: "This amazing red possesses sweetness, suppleness, and superb purity, no small accomplishment for the normally astringent, tough-textured mourvedre . . . It should drink well for 4-5 years. This is a cutting edge effort from one of Spain's backwater but soon to be famous appellations."

2001 Castano Solanera (\$9.99) 93 points from Robert Parker. There is more bang for the buck in the Castano wines than with any other vino around! Made from 70% mourvedre and 30% cabernet sauvignon, it is in a word FABULOUS! Mr Parker: "This is a custom cuvée specifically bottled for the American importer, Eric Solomon. Its opaque, inky purple color is followed by glorious aromas of blue and blackberries intermixed with graphite, minerals, smoke, and scorched earth. It is splendidly concentrated and full-bodied, with no hard edges."

Trey's Corner!

If you are a fan of high quality chardonnay and pinot noir from California chances are you have heard of Testarossa. Since 1994 over 77 Testarossa wines have been awarded a score of 90 or higher by the top trade publications. Testarossa Vineyards is located in the town of Los Gatos, approximately sixty miles south of San Francisco. Founded in 1993 by the husband and wife team of Rob & Diana Jensen, the name Testarossa (Italian for "redhead") was a nickname given to Rob when he was a young university student studying in Italy. Testarossa specializes in making high quality chardonnay and pinot noir from some of the best vineyards in California. While Testarossa bottles "single-vineyard" wines from vineyards like Sleepy Hollow, Pisoni, Michaud and Gary's Vineyard, they also have blends of chardonnay and pinot noir, many of which include these vineyards in the blend. The **2000 Castello Chardonnay (\$23.99)** is a blend of fruit from Monterey and Santa Barbara County vineyards. Flavors of pears, baked apples, spice and cream explode in your mouth when tasting this wine. The finish is clean and lively. The **2001 Palazzo Pinot Noir (\$28.99)** is a blend of fruit from Monterey, Santa Barbara and Santa Cruz vineyards. Aromas of smoked meats and bacon, reminiscent of a great burgundy, grabs you from the start of this wine and leads you to flavors of red cherries, leather, white pepper and crushed raspberries. This wine's lush and velvety texture combined with its almost seamless finish ensures another sip. Delicious! As far as cabernet goes this month I need to mention at least one. That one is the **1999 Amici Napa Cabernet Sauvignon (\$36.99)**. The Amici is a blend of fruit from 2 different vineyards; 60% from the Breckenridge Vineyard in St Helena and 40% from the Alioto Vineyard in the Rutherford benchlands. The wine shows a saturated purple color, sweet vanilla spice, black currants, blackberries and ripe blueberry flavors. This is a full-bodied cabernet that is firmly structured, rich, thick and complex. This wine is ready to enjoy now with 30 minutes of decanting, or may be cellared for an additional 10 years. — *Trey Beffa*

2000 Echelon "California" Merlot (\$9.99)

About mid-November he sent out a release notice of this cab that wowed everyone in its path. We sold so much of this wine that the good people at Atalon said we could have some more. Jim C’s The New Year View Down Under

Well, it’s that time of the year when I get on my soapbox and tout the virtues of TRYING SOMETHING NEW! We are lucky at K&L to be able to taste such a wide variety of wines that are interesting and exciting, and love nothing more than to share that excitement with you. The wine clubs and Saturday tasting bars are excellent ways to expand your horizons. And of course, talk to us. We have staff who are full of great information.

Last year, I was able to go to South Africa, and found an amazing wealth of history, culture, and potential. They have a history of making wine that dates back to the 1600s, but there is a new generation and spirit that I think will, in time, gain a presence in the wine market.

2002 Neil Ellis “Groenekloof” Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa (\$14.99)

This is stunning sauvignon blanc, with a complex bouquet of lime, snap pea, minerals, grapefruit and light grassy notes. On the palate the wine is juicy with great balance and texture.

2000 Fairview “Cyril Back” Shiraz, South Africa (\$22.99)

When I had the chance to taste this wine in South Africa I was quite impressed. It has wonderful concentration and density. Sweet blackberry fruit mingles with notes of meat, licorice, violets and bittersweet chocolate. Very fine balance and length. Don’t miss it, not much to be had!

And just so it won’t seem one-sided, here’s one for the Aussies.

2000 Hugo McLaren Vale Shiraz, South Australia (\$14.99)

The Hugo vineyards were established in 1951 by Colin Hugo, and in 1970 his son John came into the family business, exerting new influences and ideas in vineyard management. A treat, the wine offers ripe black fruits with notes of coffee, malt and chocolate. On the palate, for all its richness, there is good acidity and a velvety texture. A very fine wine for the money. All the best for the New Year, *Jim Chanteloup*

Into Winter Reds

Here we are in the middle of winter, holidays past, life coming back to normal, chilly nights, and the only thing we need is a great red wine to get us through til spring. Guess what, I know some. The **2001 Purissima Syrah from Lodi (\$10.99)** with its easy to drink, juicy, deep, black fruits, smooth oakiness and pepper spice, is a great bargain. Lodi has a wonderfully warm growing season, so the ripeness is right in character. At this price you can’t afford to miss saving a couple of these for a quiet night at home. If you are tired of the same old wines, Shypoke cellars has two good old fashioned reds the likes of which we have not seen for years. When Clyde walked in with these two wines, I thought he was losing his touch, I should know by now not to doubt the man. The **1999 Shypoke Charbono (\$16.99)** is from their vineyards in Napa, which were used in the legendary Inglenook Charbonos of the ’50s and ’60s. The wine shows a powerful and spicy nose, then follows with brambly and deep black raspberries, black cherries, and Christmas spices on the palate. With a truly solid backbone and good food pairing acid balance, this delicious wine will bring back the memories. We also have their **1999 Sangiovese (\$11.99)**, a pretty and uncomplicated bright wine, showing red cherry fruit, and an easy drinkability that will leave you wondering where the rest of the bottle went. Very pure and smooth, it’s just the wine to sip in front of the fire. For a zin, the **2000 Hartford Russian River Zin (Inquire)** is a blockbuster. Mr Parker has been giving these wines great scores, and I can see why, no amount of adjectives can describe this gem. The big, bold, black, sexy, black currant jammy nose is only a hint of what is to come in this brambly, zesty, deep, juicy, spicy zin that is so drinkable you’ll have to move fast to get yours! As I write, Anderson is lying spread-eagled on the floor with heavy eyelids, struggling to stay awake. This is after a relentless day of chasing bugs, butterflies, and birds all over our vineyard. And a morning hike up our road to the ridge two miles away and back. When he sees the red-tail hawk, that nests directly behind the house in a Redwood tree, soaring above us at the top of the ridge, he freezes and stares in what I subjectively assume in awe. For all other birds he will do what normal bird dogs do and point. Meanwhile, Ebby suns herself in our kitchen window, watching "hummingbird TV." It is almost the same as watching Sesame Street, except the hummingbirds taunt and tease her as they feed from the red sugar water feeders outside the window. What a way to end 2002 and begin the new year of 2003. The vineyard will be planted and finished after the rains stop. We're hoping for March, but probably April. Or May. I need to mention one correction to my December column. It's not totally true that we plan to put in exclusively four different Dijon clones of pinot noir. About a year ago, Jeff Vierra and Eric Story approached me and asked me if they could add several rows of a special Germanic clone of Riesling at the vineyard site. I finally told them okay, except that they would have to take care of the plantings *and* pay me an annual rent of four to five cases of Riesling a year. We'll keep you abreast of this one, too!

The New Year's Gems are as follows.

2001 Zinfandel "Dancing Bull," Rancho Zabaco (\$7.99) is a wonderfully delicious zin that offers balance, depth of structure, a lovely fleshy quality, and is produced by the Gallos of Sonoma.

(🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

If you are looking for a rich, highly extracted, spicy wine that has tremendous depth, balance and lushness, then look no further: the **2001 Kalinda Syrah, Central Coast (\$11.99)** is your glass of wine. Soft, round, and plummy, this is a lovely syrah. Anderson says that it is worth at least a case in your wine collection.

We have two direct import village reds from the southern Rhône Valley that are stunning examples and exceptional buys from that area. I have written and recommended previous vintages from these two producers. **2000 Château de Montfaucon Côtes-du-Rhône (\$8.99)** should be considered a Châteauneuf-du-Pape, but due to the fact that it lies directly across the river (the boundary line) from that infamous commune, it can only be designated general valley red. Produced from 60% grenache, 15% syrah, 10% cinsault, and 15% carignane, the little beauty is loaded white pepper spiciness both in the nose and on the palate. It is fresh and lively on the finish, and shows a long, pronounced finish. Both Anderson and Ebby have indicated that this will be one of our two house reds for the month. Superb value! (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

Our other house red for the month will be **2001 La Chapelle Notre Dame d'Aubune Beaugues de Venise, Côtes-du-Rhône-Villages (\$8.99)**. The 2001 vintage in the Rhône Valley is an incredibly great one, and this Beaugues de Venise is unbelievably rich and full, with opulent aromas of black pepper, plums and anise. In the mouth, you will be treated to full-blown, deeply flavored wine of length and complexity. Don't miss this super value; it will sell out quickly. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷).

I sat up, and the blacksmith in my noggin commenced his workday with all of the fervor of a kid in a candy store. This guy was working so hard I figured he must be in the last year of his contract. Luckily, the clank of hammer to anvil was offset by a flaming orb that busied itself by searing its initials into my blood orange pupils. S U N ! It must be morning, I must have a hangover, and on top of that I need to find a way to work a damn blind anchovy into this yarn.

The rotary phone belled out the end of recess as I mainlined caffeine in a desperate attempt to imitate human behavior. I picked up as I sat down, and listened up as I looked down. I was starting to feel like an indecisive elevator. "Joe Berg, P.I. Good rates, middling service, bad manners. What can I do you for?" A voice like an ocean of silk danced from the receiver. "Mr Berg, I'll get right to the point. My husband, Jim Boy Barr has vanished. I need you to find him. His life is in danger." Same for the guy forging a sword in my head, I thought. But there was something about this woman . . . then it hit me like an ace in a poker game: It was Abbey—red hair and more legs than you can imagine, wife of the notorious gangster Jim Boy Barr, wanted in 10 states for taking 35 vacations in the last 5 years, or something like that. "Will you help me, Mr Berg?" "Call me Joe," I rasped as I eyed the empty bottle of **1989 Pavié** at my feet. A great wine, and wonderful company at five in the morning—warm merlot fruit, soft tannins and a lovely, cedar/spice quality that can only come from years in the bottle. And priced right. I looked away. "I'll take the case, Abbey. Meet me at Joe's on the corner of Hyde and Seike." I hung up. I was hung up on Abbey, and she knew it. But could I find Jim Boy Barr?

Abbey and I shared a bottle of **1989 Cos d'Estournel**, and I couldn't decide which was more exotic. The Cos is a huge wine, with grace and finesse: meaty, cedary notes with a ripe, supple mid palate of red and black fruits. Lovely. "The last time I saw Jim Boy he was on his way to work at K&L. He never got there." Oh, I thought, there's a surprise. The man rarely worked at all—he was out of the office more than a park ranger. I smiled like the Grinch with a bird in his mouth, not an easy thing to do.

I searched the city by the Bay from top to bottom, searching the bottom as little as possible. I asked questions. I called in favors. I drank wine. My desperation was temporarily alleviated by a bottle of **1993 Latour**, and the Great Wine was all that and more—probably the star of the vintage, concentrated and masculine with more lush black fruit than Carmen Miranda's hat, and sandalwood notes to the nose that would make a hippy go to heaven. But Jim Boy had vanished. I had one paragraph to go.

Back in the office and out of the graying mists of the city, I was startled by the bell of the rotary phone, ringing like an Edgar Allen Poe title. The voice was Abbey's. "He came back! Jim Boy was at K&L the whole time, but did no work so no one knew he was there! Thank you so much, Mr. Berg! The Czech is in the mail." I said goodbye to the dial tone. It was time to celebrate.

Searching for supper, I walked through Chinatown, looking at the exotic food displays, and I happened upon a bucket at the seafood market. I looked into the water and there, bumping repeatedly against the sides, was an anchovy. And just in time. (*Cue the sax.*) THE END. —Joe Z

Smell of gooseberries, grapefruit, flowers, even currants, all held together with vibrant and racy acidity and a flinty mineral finish. Not too much to ask when you have the **2001 Menetou-Salon "Clos des Blanchais," Henri Pelle (\$13.99)**, a superb example of Menetou-Salon, a small village next to Sancerre in the Loire Valley. The chalky soils of this region are perfect for sauvignon blanc, giving the wines flinty, racy aromas and crisp finishes. This offering from Pelle is full of ripe grapefruit and citrus flavors. It's full-bodied with a long crisp finish. This is a single vineyard wine that is a bit richer than the regular bottling and has a kiss of oak. Also, the **2001 Franck Millet Sancerre (\$10.99)**, with pronounced aromas of figs, melons, and terroir; the flavors are dry, clean, crisp, with a fine minerality on the palate. We have been incredibly pleased with the new 2001 vintage of Sancerre from Franck Millet. A true Sancerre style at a great price. Cheers! —*Jeff V*

Pour Votre Plaisir

It is January, with short days and colder weather. After the hubbub and chaos of the Holiday season the relative calm of a quiet winter day or evening is a welcome respite. This time of year always makes me think of impromptu dinner parties with good friends, and sitting in front of a crackling fire with a glass of wine. I'll make a few suggestions of some of our latest acquisitions you may want to enjoy.

We found some amazing buys at the end of the calendar year, as the green eyeshade types at some of the importers turned up the heat on the sales force with respect to inventory levels. We also found some amazing values in everyday burgundy from some top domaines. There was a time when everyday burgundy was an oxymoron, and there really was not much of it, unless your budget was particularly generous. But now, times have changed, and there are some extraordinary values. Of course quantities are limited on these values.

The **2000 Bourgogne Rouge, Domaine J.M. Boillot (\$11.99)** is soft, lovely and rich, showing lots of charm, but also more density and tannins than you might expect. The high quality stems directly from Jean-Marc's willingness to throw out any unhealthy or unripe grapes. The **2000 Bourgogne Rouge, Domaine Mongeard Mugneret (\$12.99)** shows ripe fruit and toasty oak. It is a charming Bourgogne Rouge from Vincent Mongeard. Quite a surprise as to just how good, and how approachable and charming, this wine is. When we tasted at the domaine in March 2002, Vincent described his 2000s as rich, full, accessible and forward. This one is all of that. For a more special occasion do not miss the **1999 Pommard, "Fremiers," 1er Cru, Domaine du Courcel (\$39.99)**. Since Yves Confuron has taken over here, this domaine is on an absolute roll, producing great wines, particularly in 1999. The Fremiers comes from a vineyard on the border with Volnay, and shows the aromatic qualities of that village, accompanied by Pommard density.

Some extraordinary whites have also arrived. The **1999 Chassagne Montrachet, "Maltroie," 1er Cru, Domaine Colin Deleger (\$39.99)** is one of our sweetheart deals. Usually \$64.99, this shows great length, focus and subtlety. The **1998 Puligny Montrachet, Domaine Gerard Chavy (\$29.99; normally \$42.99)** is soft, elegant, supple Puligny. Finally, in a move that had our staff saying "They did WHAT?!", the importer closed out a fabulous **1998 Corton Charlemagne, Grand Cru, Domaine Bonneau du Martray at \$59.99**. Normally selling for \$80-100 or more, this received 93 points from the *Wine Spectator*. They wrote: "Vibrant. Clean and lively, with lovely midpalate concentration, this medium- to full-bodied white Burgundy is straight as an arrow. Fabulous balance of subtle toasted oak and ripe fruit. An ager. Best from 2002 through 2008" So, they waited until the wine was really good, then slashed the price. Go figure. —Keith Wollenberg

It is a beautiful vintage, and when all the dust settles, the 1998s may turn out to be the most balanced, concentrated, fragrant, and compelling Barolos and Barbarescos of the extraordinary trilogy of 1996, 1997, and 1998. Time will ultimately be the final arbiter, but it is a profound vintage of classic but accessible wines." *Wine Advocate*, Issue 135, June 2001.

If you haven't figured it out by now, I am a huge fan of the 1999 vintage in Tuscany. 1999 is a classically styled vintage, long, elegant, and power packed with fruit that has the freshness of morning bursting out at you. Not the ripe, tired feeling of a long, very hot afternoon. I've never been a huge fan of the cabernet movement in Italy, not that I think that cabernet isn't a good grape, or doesn't do well in Italy, there are just so many other grapes of interest, why repeat what has been done? First off, you can generally sell cabernet for a lot more money and it is the lingua franca of the wine world, that's why! California cabernet prices have taken a rather abrupt upward turn over the last decade, and the super Tuscan "Aia" wines got famous and followed suit now selling at \$100-\$200, if you can get your hands on any. Montalcino has been the standard bearer for Italy and Tuscan wines for the last 80 years but only this last year with the super hype over the 1997 Brunello vintage were they taken seriously outside the core of Italophiles. Where am I going with this? Well, all rolled into one, from the superb 1999 vintage comes a cabernet sauvignon-based super Tuscan from Montalcino! Solaria, the project of dynamic winemaker and owner Patrizia Cencioni is a blend of 70% cabernet sauvignon coupled with 30% sangiovese, and in her hands these two grapes intertwine into a truly spectacular wine. We've tasted a lot of

big name California cabernets lately in the \$60-\$100 range, that I would love to see in a tasting with this wine. The **1999 Solaria "Solarianne" Super Tuscan (\$59.99)** will absolutely thrill you with the depth of its flavors, the layers of spice, dense fruit with a core of concentration to ensure longevity but luxuriant enough to drink now. "Solarianne" is a unique combination of the power, density, and chocolatey ripeness of cabernet sauvignon and sangiovese that gives length, brightness and a core of cherries and plums that linger in a long-lasting finish. It has everything that you'd want in a Napa cabernet, ripeness, smooth, chocolatey and drinkability but "Solarianne" has the suave elegance of restrained power (of restrained alcohol too, apologies to Helen Turley). It's a gentle, well-mannered, sort of a muscular Marcello Mastroianni. Solaria is a small winery and "Solarianne" is a very small production. Because so little is imported to the USA, don't look for a splashy review among the full page, color, glossy ads in the *Wine Spectator*. However, the *Gambero Rosso*, Italy's version of the *Wine Spectator* gave Solaria's 1997 Brunello 3 glasses, its highest award, and 2 red glasses to the "Solarianne," its second highest score. The 1999 "Solarianne" is drinkable now; I'd suggest decanting for 2-3 hours ahead, or aging for 10-15 years.

Jeff's Picks: Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt

We all know by now that 2001 is a tremendous vintage and one of the most blessed spots was the Middle Mosel from Trittenheim to Erden where the most expressive, aromatic, and elegant white wines in the world are fashioned from its steep banks. Just outside the town of Graach lies the Josephshof, a monopole vineyard and property owned by the Reichsgraf von Kesselsatt Estate since the early 1800s when Napoleon secularized the church property. The Josephshof produces wines with a blend of the firm mineral character of the Graach wines and the seductive elegance of the Wehlen wines. Peach mingled with lime blossom, pear, and blackcurrant, lovely fine grip and nerve that echoes on the palate. We have two wines for you from the Josephshof: **2001 Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt Josephshofer Kabinett (\$16.99)**, which is very clear and precise, snappy, lively in the mouth and positively sumptuous; and the **2001 Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt Josephshofer Spätlese (\$21.99)**, only 250 cases were made of this serious riesling. Broader and denser than the Kabinett with great structure and minerality, tangy and vivacious, this little darling just wants to relax a few more years. —Your back page man, *Jeff Vierra*
